

- 8. Snapping the focus and head during a turn to help diminish dizziness 5. a straight-leg kick passing through the tendu and degage, brushing and clarify the turn.
- 9. back, side, front
- 10. A turn performed on one leg with the other leg in passé.
- 12. 180 turn with shift of weight
- 15. step cross, rock side, step in place
